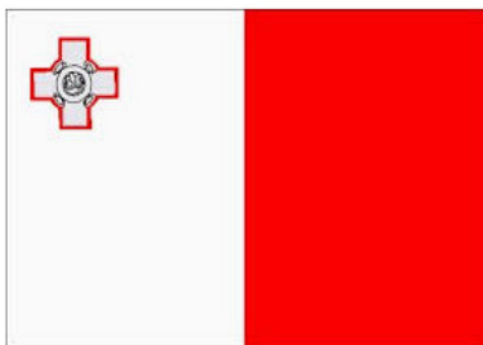


## Public void puzzle();
